
# Book Reviews by Pinewood Readers! (more reviews on page 2)




Book: *My Own Special Way* by Mithaa AlKhayyat (ER FRE)

Book: Henry and Leo by Pamela Zagarenski (E ZAG)




Book: *The Hunter's Code* by Jake Maddox (FIC MAD)

book. If you like the book, check out the others in this adventurous series.




